Documents Required for Admission: Must be submitted in original language and accompanied by an English translation

- 1. If still attending secondary school:
 - a. Examination results for the Standard (X) exam should be submitted, years 9 and 10 equivalent.
- 2 If completed secondary school:
 - a. Examination results for the Standard (X) exam and Standard (XII) should be submitted, years 9, 10, 11, and 12 equivalent.
 - b. Official copy of: <u>Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) or Higher Secondary School</u> <u>Certificate (HSSC)</u>
- 3. Applicants must arrange for or to send the exam results directly to Pepperdine University.

Indian National Curriculum/International Secondary Schools (Mixed Credentials)

Required Documents:

- 1. If applicant has attended different curriculum institutions,
 - a. If still attending secondary school, examination results for the Standard (X) exam and transcripts from each institution attended must be submitted.
 - b. If completed secondary school, examination results for the Standard (X) exam and all other transcripts/exam results for each institution attended.
 - i. IB exam results or AS Level/A Level exam results

International Secondary Schools Required Documents

1. American Curriculum:

*Arrange for official academic transcripts indicating all exams taken and grades earned to be sent directly to Pepperdine University by the <u>IB Americas Global Centre</u> or secondary school counselor.

3 British System:

- a. Submit GCSE/IGCSE (International) General Certificate of Secondary Education, years 9 & 10 equivalent, Advanced Subsidiary Levels, year 11 equivalent, where available.*
- b. Submit GCSE/IGCSE (International) General Certificate of Secondary Education, years 9 & 10 equivalent, GCE, General Certificate of Education, Advanced Level results, years 11 & 12 equivalent.*

 *Only test scores received directly from the testing center will be considered official.

Proof of English Language Proficiency:

1. Required
